■ INSTRUCTION MANUAL

This manual describes necessary points of caution when you use this product, installation, connection and basic maintenance procedures.

POINTS OF CAUTION

■ POWER INPUT RATING & OPERATIONAL RANGE

 $24\,\mathrm{V}\,\mathrm{DC}$ $\pm10\%, 2.5\,\mathrm{A}$ minimum

ENVIRONMENT

• When heavy dust or metal particles are present in the air, install the unit inside proper housing with sufficient ventilation.

• Do not install the unit where it is subjected to continuous vibration. Do not apply physical impact to the unit.

• Environmental temperature must be within -5 to +55°C (23 to 131°F) with relative humidity within 30 to 90% RH in order to ensure adequate life span and operation.

• Be sure that the ventilation slits are not covered with cables, etc.


■ WIRING

Do not install cables (power supply, input and output) close to noise sources (relay drive cable, high frequency line, etc.).
Do not bind these cables together with those in which noises are present. Do not install them in the same duct.

■ AND

• The unit is designed to function as soon as power is supplied, however, a warm up for 10 minutes is required for satisfying complete performance described in the data sheet.






CHECKING

- 1) Terminal wiring: Check that all cables are correctly connected according to the connection diagram.
- 2) Power input voltage: Check voltage across terminals 1 (+) 2 (-). Use a power source of ripple level 10% p-p or less.
- 3) Installation & environment: Check ambient temperature. Also check that there are no excessive dust particles around. Check that there is no vibration.



■ CONNECTION DIAGRAM



INSTALLATION


■ MACHINING METHOD FOR YOKOGAWA RACK

1) Remove the top panel.




2) Make holes in both side panels.

■ RACK MOUNTING METHOD

1) Mount 18KBXW-Y2 on the machined YOKOGAWA RACK so that the PWB face of 18KBXW-Y2 fits together with the connector face of YOKOGAWA RACK.



Joint between 18KBXW-Y2 (PWB face) and YOKOGAWA RACK (Connector face)

 $2)\,Fasten\,18KBXW-Y2$ and YOKOGAWA RACK together with screws and attach the protection cover.
