### ■ INSTRUCTION MANUAL

This manual describes necessary points of caution when you use this product, including installation, connection and basic maintenance procedures.

### **POINTS OF CAUTION**

### ■ POWER INPUT RATING & OPERATIONAL RANGE

• Locate the power input rating marked on the product and confirm its operational range as indicated below:

AC power: Rating ±10%, 50/60 ±2 Hz, MDC-1: approx. 2VA MDC-2, MDC-3: approx. 3.5VA

### ■ GENERAL PRECAUTIONS

• Before you remove the unit from its base socket or mount it, turn off the power supply for safety.

### ENVIRONMENT

- Indoor use.
- When heavy dust or metal particles are present in the air, install the unit inside proper housing with sufficient ventilation.
- Do not install the unit where it is subjected to continuous vibration. Do not subject the unit to physical impact.
- Environmental temperature must be within -5 to +60°C (23 to 140°F) with relative humidity within 30 to 90% RH in order to ensure adequate life span and operation.

### ■ WIRING


- Do not install cables close to noise sources (relay drive cable, high frequency line, etc.).
- Do not bind these cables together with those in which noises are present. Do not install them in the same duct.

### ■ AND ....

• The unit is designed to function as soon as power is supplied, however, a warm up for 10 minutes is required for satisfying complete performance described in the data sheet.



### ■ HOW TO OPEN THE FRONT COVER:

Hang your finger on the hook at the top of the front cover and pull.




## **INSTALLATION**

Detach the yellow clamps located at the top and bottom of the unit for separate the body from the base socket.

#### ■ DIN RAIL MOUNTING

Set the base socket so that its DIN rail adaptor is at the bottom. Hang the upper hook at the rear side of base socket on the DIN rail and push in the lower. When removing the socket, push down the DIN rail adaptor utilizing a minus screwdriver and pull.

#### ■ WALL MOUNTING



## **TERMINAL CONNECTIONS**


Connect the unit as in the diagram below or refer to the connection diagram on the top of the unit.

### EXTERNAL DIMENSIONS unit: mm (inch)




■ CONNECTION DIAGRAM

### CHECKING

- 1) Terminal wiring: Check that all cables are correctly connected according to the connection diagram.
- 2) Power input voltage: Check voltage across the terminal 7-8 with a multimeter.
- 3) Output: Check voltage across the terminal 1 (+) 2 (–) or 3 (+) 2 (–) with a multimeter.
- 4) Output: Check that output load is within the permissible limit.

MDC-1, -2: 50mA max.

MDC-3: 65mA max. (the total of 24V/40V outputs)

## **ADJUSTMENT PROCEDURE**

· When mounting, no extra space is needed between units.

Output voltage adjustment is accessible via front potentiometer behind the front cover.

- 1) Open the front cover so that OUTPUT ADJ. potentiometer is exposed.
- 2) Connect a multimeter across the output terminal 1 (+) 2 (–).
- 3) Turn the potentiometer clockwise or counterclockwise until desired voltage reading is obtained.
